## The Why

In any challenging activity, you have to find your "Why"; the reason you do what you do...what motivates you to work harder each day in pursuit of perfection. Running a film festival is no exception. This year, I found that "why" in philanthropy.

ASPIRA of Florida is a non-profit organization, which provides youth with a variety of leadership development opportunities facilitated by its staff of young professionals who can relate to the needs of today's youth, and provide educational services in a culturally competent and youth-focused manner. This year, I was given the distinct honor of teaching these students an introductory filmmaking class from an "indie" perspective. I found these students to be incredibly talented and passionate about learning. While the world may classify them as "at risk" (given the socio-economic factors affecting their lives), I can say with absolute conviction that, if they continue down the path that ASPIRA is creating for them, they are at risk of having amazing success in life! I am eternally grateful for the opportunity to teach them.


Glam-A-THON™ is a non-profit that has donated \$333,000 over the past four years to benefit the Lillian S. Well's Women's Health Center and the Lisa Boccard Breast Cancer Fund, with all proceeds helping to fund free mammograms, diagnostic testing, and other needs associated with those undergoing breast cancer treatment. As a person who has had very close family members die of Cancer, I am constantly irritated by the fact that humanity can create advanced weaponry and send people into outer-space but we can't find a cure for one disease. Thus, I am an avid supporter of Glam-A-Thon and had the honor of singing with the band "Crossover" at their most recent fundraising event, earlier this month.

EL SUEÑO is a film about human rights. It is the story of two children, whose parents are murdered by vigilantes in order to prevent their crossing the US/Mexico border. The kids make it to the US as orphans and the story follows them as they struggle to overcome adversity and temptation, clinging to the hope that the Dream Act legislation will pass. This REAL-LIFE proposed law would provide a path to citizenship for these two immigrants and many others like them. The legislative debate regarding the Dream Act Legislation (and Immigration Reform in general) form the backdrop of this 90-minute feature film. This year, I had the honor of directing this film, which is now complete and scheduled for release in 2016. Although we shot the film in El Paso, Texas, IMMIGRATION REFORM affects a tremendous number of people in South Florida, so it is a part of what Miami Web Fest brings to the community.

So, there you have it: the "Why"
