The Miami Web Fest is a four day festival showcasing the hottest new web series content from around the world. Taking place from September 29 – October 2, the city of Miami is on full display throughout this gala, with the distinct South Beach and Miami cultures creating a work/play atmosphere that is unlike any other web film festival in the world.

The city of Miami now boasts the world's most prestigious event for digital filmmakers, as the 3rd Annual Miami Web Fest christens the city of Miami as the new hub for aspiring TV and film creators in the 21st century. Executives and former executives from Netflix, HBO, AMC and more will serve as judges at the Miami Web Fest, offering feedback and advice to the hundreds of digital filmmakers from around the world who were selected by the festival. Created in 2014 by award-winning filmmaker and US Army veteran Bryan Thompson, the Miami Web Fest offers aspiring digital filmmakers the chance to be discovered by an unprecedented panel of judges and industry executives. It also allows the general public the rare opportunity to discover the next big hit show or movie before it is redeveloped by major networks.






